Day 1: Arrival

This is the day your wander starts off at Naha International Airport. Bus transfer will take you directly to the hotel.

Day 2: Northern Okinawa

First day of the tour is taken place in Northern Okinawa. Head to north after breakfast, first stop is at Ryukyumura where reproduces Ryukyu-era's village and people's life. The next stop is at Cape Manza. The elephant's nose shaped rock stands out in beautiful East China Sea. Nago Pineapple Park is the next destination where automatic carts guide you through large open pineapple fields and some other tropical plants. Highlight of this northern Okinawa tour is at Ocean Expo Park, built in 1975 for Okinawa International Ocean Expo. One of the largest aquarium tanks is located at Churaumi Aquarium that amazes you with multiple whales and sharks. As well as aquarium, astonishing dolphin show entertains you for FREE.

Day 3: Southern Historical and Cultural Tour

This day's first stop is at Fukushuen. It is traditional Chinese garden. You will see Okinawan culture and tradition at Okinawa World. You may experience many cultural things and crafts. The main attraction is Lime stone cave which stretch underground for over 5km (800 m is open to public). At the next stop, Himeyuri Memorial Museum, you will see Okinawa's sad history. During the Battle of Okinawa, female junior high school students were called for the duty of nursing injured armies, but finally they were released from the duty and many of them died. After taste of history and culture, enjoy at Outlet Mall Ashibina offering over 70 shops around the world.

Day 4: Central Okinawa

After breakfast, FREE TIME in Kokusai Street, a mile road with souvenir shops, fashion boutiques, gourmet restaurants lined up on both sides of the street. The next stop is at Shuri Castle, the palace of the Ryukyu Kingdom. It was served as the centre of the government of the Ryukyu until Okinawa became prefecture in 1879. Learn history at museum inside. Next stop is at Don Quixote which is Japanese popular chain store, offering various kinds of things, such as electronic products in really cheap price. The last stop is American Village where you can enjoy FREE TIME here. This is American theme town offers variety of shopping store, entertainment spots and restaurants.

Day 5: Departure

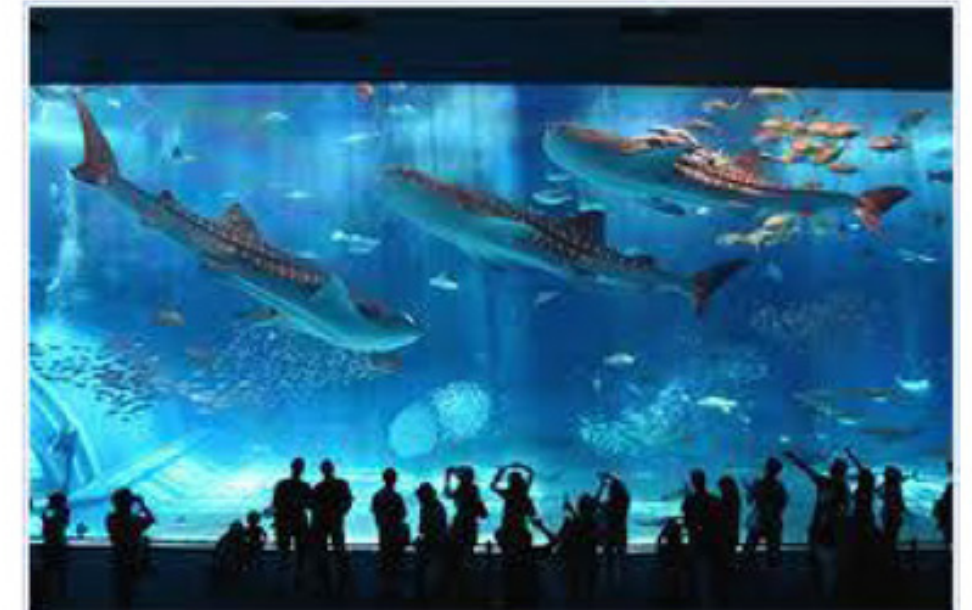
Farewell to Okinawa. Transfer to the airport in the morning after breakfast.
