TOURS IN JAPAN 5D4N Okinawa Tour

Day 1: Arrival

This is the day your wander starts off at Naha International Airport. Bus transfer will take you directly to the hotel.

Day 2: Northern Okinawa (B, L, D)

First day of the tour is taken place in Northern Okinawa. Head to north after breakfast, first stop is at Cape Manza. The elephant's nose shaped rock stands out in beautiful East China Sea. Okinawa Fruits Land is the next destination where you can learn about fruits through playing game and answering quiz. Highlight of this northern Okinawa tour is at Ocean Expo Park, built in 1975 for Okinawa International Ocean Expo. One of the largest aquarium tanks is located at Churaumi Aquarium that amazes you with multiple whales and sharks. As well as aquarium, astonishing dolphin show entertains you for FREE. After dinner, you will have free time at American Village, American theme town offers variety of shopping store, entertainment spots and restaurants.

Day 3: Central Okinawa (B, L, D)

The first stop on this day is at Ryukyu Village where reproduces traditional Ryukyu style village and you can enjoy the show called "Michi June-" which used to be done to entertain Ryukyu King. The second stop is at Don Quixote where you will find various kinds of things at cheap price, such as electronic things. The next stop is at Shuri Castle, the palace of the Ryukyu Kingdom. It was served as the centre of the government of the Ryukyu until Okinawa became prefecture in 1879. Learn history at museum inside.

Day 4: Southern Okinawa (B, L, D)

You will see Okinawa culture and tradition at Okinawa World. You may experience many cultural things and crafts. The main attraction is Lime stone cave which stretch underground for over 5km (800m is open to public). The next stop is at Ryukyu Glass Village, a factory of Okinawa traditional craft products, Ryukyu Glass. There is also a large store of Ryukyu Glass. At Chuko Awamori Factory, you can see how to make Okinawa traditional sake, Awamori. After taste of history and culture, enjoy at outlet Mall Ashibina offering over 70 shops around the world.

Day 5: Departure (B)

Farewell to Okinawa. Transfer to the airport in the morning after breakfast.


